HOW TO PACKAGE HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE FOR TRANSPORTATION

The guidelines for safely transporting Household Hazardous Waste to collection sites are as follows:

- Keep all products in original containers with labels intact.
- Wrap leaking containers in newspaper and place in a plastic bag or garbage container.
- Make sure all lids and caps are tight.
- Place items securely in a box for transport. Use newspaper or cardboard as filler.
- Place chemicals, which will react with one another, in separate parts of the vehicle.
- DO NOT leave materials in hot, unventilated area for long periods of time.
- DO NOT SMOKE NEAR CHEMICALS
